PanCare and other medical support agencies have agreed to bring their mobile care vehicles to offer dental, hearing and visual support in real time at that location.

Churches, Non-profits, Alzheimer's and Dementia support groups and any one that provides direct help to the people of Bay County can share their services.

Service Agencies can have "volunteers" helping county residents apply for resources.

Drug Intervention and Treatment agencies can have staff explain and encourage residents who need support for themselves or family members.

Mental Health Agencies can offer support for intake and registration for assistance by helping complete intake applications on site.

Services such as completing applications for new social security cards will be appreciated.

This will a fun day. Music will be played with the upbeat sounds of victory and celebration.
